Framed by the colorful mass ascensions of the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta, this top-notch juried show features the work of more than 250 fine artists and craftspeople from throughout the U.S. The artists report great sales, and our shoppers are captivated by artist demonstrations, fun kid’s activities, and the live music and delicious food in our shaded outdoor pavilion— all of which add up to a ranking as one of the “Top 30” in *Sunshine Artist’s* “200 Best Shows,” and a spot as one of New Mexico’s best loved annual events.

LOCATION & EXHIBITOR SPACE The 14-acre Festival site is ideally located to attract traffic from the Balloon Fiesta, and to be convenient to city residents. Located at the southwest corner of I-25 and Paseo del Norte, one of the busiest intersections in the city, there is easy access from the frontage road as well as acres of free parking.

The 20th Annual Rio Grande Arts & Crafts Festival will be held in a 40,000 square foot, fully enclosed, semi-permanent structure complete with astroturf. Approximately 250 booth spaces will be available for exhibiting artists. Standard spaces are 10' x 10' deep. Exhibitors must supply their own back and sidewalls. Pipe and drape is also available to rent. Center row spaces are 15' x 5' deep with draping along the back wall only.

The Outdoor Artist’s Market and the Culinary Art Booths are located in the outdoor pavilion area. Spaces are on astroturf and exhibitors supply their own canopies. Canopies must be fireproof and approved by the Fire Marshal. Electricity is not available.

Overnight security will be provided during the Festival and also Monday through Thursday so exhibitors displaying indoors both weekends can remain set up. 400 watts of electricity for indoor booths will be available for purchase.

LOCATION & EXHIBITOR SPACE The Holiday Rio Grande Arts & Crafts Festival will be held in the Lujan Exhibit Complex at Expo NM. The Festival site is a familiar venue to all who live in Albuquerque and is centrally located in the heart of the city. There is easy access to I-40, close proximity to hotels, restaurants, and shopping malls as well as ample parking.

Approximately 200 booth spaces will be available. All spaces are 10' deep. Exhibitors must supply their own back and side walls. Draping may be rented. 400 watts of electricity may be purchased. Overnight security will be provided during the Festival.

We welcome you to join us for the 9th Annual Holiday Show this Thanksgiving Weekend! Exhibitors applying to both October and November shows at the same time may waive the \$25.00 entry fee for November. Please fill out the entry form and mail it in by April 1, 2008.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY The jurying committee will review the slides and photos of each entrant and select exhibitors based on ranked jury point totals. The following criteria will be taken into consideration: quality of work, mastery of medium, originality, artistic design, focus, marketability and booth display. Work exhibited must be consistent with that shown in slides or photos. At least 30% of the spaces will be reserved for new exhibitors. A limited number of outdoor booths are available for specialty food sampling adjacent to the outdoor artist market area.

Works may incorporate some commercially produced parts, but the work's design and execution must be primarily the product of the exhibiting artist's skill. Categories are limited. Once each category is full, an alternate list will be compiled, and these alternates will be offered spaces as they become available.

No imports or manufactured items will be accepted. Items with reproductions of the exhibitor's artwork on them (art tiles, mugs, etc.) must be listed specifically on the entry form and submitted with additional photos for consideration by the jury. These items may not make up more than 10% of items displayed in booth.

APPLICATION Two checks should accompany each application: a \$25.00 non-refundable entry fee (applies to ALL applicants) and a deposit equal to half of the booth fee (refundable, if not accepted). Booth fees may be charged. (See Entry Form). If also applying to November at this time, \$25 November entry fee is waived and November deposit is reduced to \$100. Submit in a separate check.

For each medium to be displayed, all applicants must submit 5 digital images representative of the quality and variety of their work, plus a digital image of their booth display. Include biographical information or a resumé, as well as a description of the artistic process if it is not apparent. Images should be PDF or JPEG, 300 dpi, 3" x 5" or 4" x 6". Images prepared for Zapplication are acceptable. Image files should be e-mailed to photos@riograndefestivals.com. Each image must be separately labeled (renamed) with exhibitor's last name, as well as, numbered 1-6, e.g. Smith 1, Smith 2, etc. Images must show work that has been completed in the last 2 years. If you do not have digital images, your slides and photos will be juried as is, but upon acceptance they will be scanned and converted to digital images resulting in an additional charge of \$30.00 for the 6 images.

Upon acceptance, the committee will choose one image suitable for the website gallery (proper lighting, strong colors, and plain background will work best).

Two exhibitors (only) may share a booth (\$75 additional charge per weekend). Submit one entry form per exhibitor and designate one person responsible for fees. Booth sizes and weekend requests will be honored in the order received, provided booth fees have been paid in full by the deadlines. A form to request corner spaces will be provided with the acceptance letter. Electricity will be automatically added to 2nd half of payment for indoor spaces, but may be subtracted, if not needed.

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS

NOVEMBER 2008 Show

EARLY SET-UP Wednesday, November 26, 1PM–6 PM; **SET-UP** Thursday, November 27, 10 AM–7 PM;

Friday, November 28 – Finishing Touches 6AM–8:30AM – Show opens 9 AM

Exhibitors who have not called or checked in by 4:00 PM on Thursday will be considered a no-show and will forfeit their booth.

BOOTH DISPLAYS AND STRUCTURES

Work that is presented attractively can be an important factor in sales as well as a positive contribution to the overall appearance of the show. Please plan your booth carefully and make sure it's attractive and easy for customers to come in and look at your work.

- Each booth must have solid fire-proofed display panels or draping on the back and sides to create a partition between booths as well as a backdrop behind it. Exhibitors who do not provide partitions must rent pipe and draping from the Festival. Canopy frames may be used, but canopy walls are not a professional look for indoors. Do not use canopy tops indoors.
- Tables must be covered or skirted to the floor on all sides showing, with a suitable, professional looking cover.
- Display a sign with your name or your company name.
- Carpet is recommended for the November show. Please secure edges with tape.
- No "Sale" or "Discount" signs. All signs should look professional.
- No signs or flyers advertising other shows or businesses.
- Displays must be contained within booth boundaries and may not interfere with adjacent booths or aisle space in any way (no over hangs or extensions).
- Exhibitor's chairs must be inside booth at October show. One chair may be in the aisle in November show.
- Do not attach anything to the tent walls, exhibit hall walls or draping.
- Exhibitor will reimburse Festival for inflicting damage to premises or equipment.
- All exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area clean during show hours, including clean-up at end of show.

ELECTRICITY AND LIGHTING October electricity is \$75 per week-end. Electricity is not available to outdoor booths. November electricity is \$45. There is a 400-watt limit for both shows, strictly enforced. Anyone not complying with the wattage limit will lose electrical privileges. Electricity fee will be billed with second half of payment.

SECURITY Overnight security for shows will be provided, but each artist is ultimately responsible for their own work. There will be full-time security during the week in October; however, anything left inside the tent during the week is at the exhibitor's risk. Neither the Festival nor its employees, directors, volunteers or insurance company are financially liable for losses or damages of any kind. Exhibitors should make arrangements with their own insurance companies for proper coverage. Exhibitors, in both shows, must cover/close their booths when show is

closed. Inventory left during the week (in October) must be covered and secured to protect it from wind and rain. Outdoor booths should break down between weeks, but may leave some display items and covered inventory in lowered canopies.

RV PARKING RV parking will be available on site at both shows.

SALES TAX & BUSINESS REGISTRATION Sales tax in NM is 6.875% for the October show. The November show's tax is 5.8125%. You are responsible for collecting and reporting it. We will have tax packets available for you. City of Albuquerque business registration license (required for the October show only) is \$35. The form will be included in acceptance packets.

RESTRICTIONS Festival Management reserves the right to remove items that have been falsely entered or are found to be manufactured, imported, not made by the artist, or any that are unsuitable or objectionable for a family-oriented Festival. This includes music, noise, scents, printed materials or anything else that the management finds objectionable. Refunds will not be given in these cases. Music booths must provide headphones for customers to listen to the music. Live musical demonstrations must be limited to a total of 15 minutes per hour.

CHILDREN AND PETS Pets are not permitted at the Festival, unless they are for handicap assistance. Children must stay with you in your booth and may not freely roam around the show. They are welcome to visit the Kids Creation Station™, please limit this to one hour per day.

CANCELLATION POLICY Cancellations must be received before June 15, for the October show, and by July 15, for the November show. A \$100 penalty will be deducted from the refund. After above mentioned dates, refunds will be made for 50% of the booth fees. Six weeks before opening day of the show, refunds will be made for 20% of the total fees. This policy also applies to exhibitors who have signed up for both weekends of the October show and cancel one weekend. If total booth fees are not received in our office by designated deadline, booth may be cancelled and resold without refund.
